

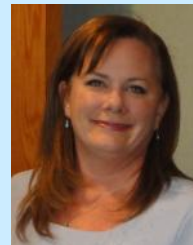

## Ways & Means Item of the Month

### Unikat Armed Forces Polish Pottery Plate



Polish Pottery originated as a folk art in the southwestern town of Boleslawiec. Thanks to rich deposits of stoneware clay occurring in the nearby Bobr River basin, the town gained the rank of an important pottery center as early as the 17th century. With early decorations inspired by the peacock feathers, farmers in the area produced the original designs using carved potatoes to create patterns in earth-tone colors. Today, artists continue this folk art by using natural sea sponges to apply the lead-free paint to their creations. New colors, as well as variations of the traditional blue, green and sienna, have been added to the artists' color

palette. The artists of the Signature Line are the most highly accomplished and earn the privilege of creating their own work from start to finish. Their pieces are hand-signed and designated as "Unikat" which simply means unique. Because of the time and artistic talent required for these pieces, they are rare and command higher prices. Although the designs vary from the traditional to Unikat, the basic colors remain the same. This allows collectors of the stoneware to display their own personal style by mixing and matching patterns. Dinner plates measure approximately 10 1/2" in diameter. These Unikat plates are highly decorative, non-toxic and durable enough for everyday use. They are provided with holes in the back for hanging. SUPPLIES ARE LIMITED and won't be re-stocked.
